

Spinal & Peripheral Manipulation Course

David Lintonbon is coming to Finland to teach a joint manipulation course on Fri–Sun, Nov 21–23, 2025.



About the course:

The Spinal & Peripheral Manipulation course covers manipulation techniques for the thoracic spine, lumbar spine, neck, rib area, and peripheral joints. In addition to manipulation techniques, mobilization and MET (Muscle Energy Techniques) for each area will also be taught.

David will be joined by Emily Ho as a co-instructor.

The course will be conducted in English.

Summary videos of the course days will be made and shared for the personal use of course participants after the event.

Course location: Atlas College in Espoo, Finland

The course is primarily intended for osteopaths, physiotherapists, and naprapaths, or students in these fields, who hold a healthcare-related degree.

Participants must be in good health and able to both perform and receive manipulations.

The joint manipulation training held by David last November received excellent feedback, with an average rating of 9.7/10

Course fee: 3 days for €520 + VAT 25.5% = €652,60

The course fee is paid upon registration.
